The smell of early morning dew as you ride on horseback through the pasture. The taste of farm-fresh eggs. The pride of showing your goats at the fair. Everyone has very personal reasons for being a hobby farmer, but there is a common thread among all—you love this way of life.

And now you can help protect it.

Premises Identification

Through the premises identification process, a confidential statewide directory of animal owners is being created. This will make it easier for state animal officials to alert you of an animal disease outbreak.

The Hobby Farmer's Role

Your involvement is key for the overall success of Locate In 48. If you own animals that are included in the program, regardless of the number of animals or their purpose, the Idaho State Department of Agriculture is encouraging you to register your premises today.

Even though your animals may never leave your land, many diseases can still spread. Idaho's Locate In 48 program is specifically designed to help protect animals in the event of a disease outbreak—ultimately helping to prevent the spread of a disease to your acreage.

Frequently Asked Questions

What are premises?

Premises are any location where animals are managed or held. This includes hobby farms.

What is a premises identification number?

A premises identification number is a unique seven-digit code assigned to a physical location.

What animals are considered to be livestock for this program?

All cattle, bison, swine, sheep, goats, poultry, horses, cervids (deer, elk), camelids (llama, alpacas), captive game birds, and aquaculture are considered livestock.

Why should horses be included in this program?

Horses can be infected with and transmit many of the highly contagious diseases that afflict traditional livestock and poultry.

Is this a mandatory program?

Participation in Idaho's premises registration program is voluntary.

Will the information I share about my premises and animals be kept confidential?

Yes, the information you provide is confidential according to Idaho law (Title 25-207B, Chapter 2, Idaho Code). Only state animal health and public health officials may access the data in the event of an animal disease outbreak or a public safety emergency.

How much does it cost to have my premises registered?

There is no cost for registering premises.

What is the connection between Idaho's Locate In 48 program and NAIS?

Locate In 48 is a state-driven program designed to support the NAIS efforts on a local level. Its purpose is to build understanding about the important role a disease traceback program can play for commercial and noncommercial producers in Idaho.
